Vendor set up begins at 10am on Saturday March 23, 2024. All vehicles and trailers must be out of the festival area no later than noon. Be ready for business no later than 12:30pm. Vendors shall not vacate the site until 5 pm. Vendors will break down space immediately after event. Vendors are responsible for their trash. DO NOT leave boxes, garbage bags, etc. in the area when you leave. Trash left in your space will result in a \$30 additional fee. There will be a large dumpster located at the venue for trash disposal.

The Cape Coral Museum of History holds the right to not allow vendors to sell items that are deemed unsafe or not appropriate for the event. Subleasing your space is prohibited. Vendors that do not comply will be removed from the event with no refund. The Vendor shall be responsible to satisfy all local, State, and Federal laws and regulations regarding health, life safety, insurance, and other requirements for your product or service.
